

## **Red Hen Data and Tools**

In this workshop, participants will learn step by step how to carry out their own multimodal corpus study based on the NewsScape 2016 corpus, a collection of more than 30,000 hours of American TV News. This will include a hands-on session introducing CQPweb and the Rapid Annotator. Furthermore, a set of data processing tools to be used on such data will be presented in a live demo, including computer-vision tools such as body key-pose detection software for the analysis of co-speech gesture. All software used is freely available and the data are provided free of charge by the Distributed Little Red Hen Lab, a global co-operative of researchers in multimodal communication.
